Summer Safari

The Republic R-III School District is excited to offer, for a second year, summer care for students in Kindergarten through 6th grade. This program will be limited to the **first 60** students (5-12 years old) that enroll and will operate from 6:30am until 6:30pm at the Republic Early Childhood Center.

Programming will be available starting May 26th and run through August 18th.

Program/Payment Options Available:

***Prepay** for the entire summer (which includes before/after school care during Summer School) - **\$670 Note: Entire Summer fees must be paid in full before May 25th.**

*Fees for Full Summer Care:

May - \$60
June - \$160
July - \$345
August - \$180



Before/After School Care during Summer School Only for K-6: AM \$35, PM \$130, AM/PM \$165

A \$15 enrollment fee is due at time of enrollment.

Tuition fees may be scheduled to pay on a weekly, biweekly or monthly schedule. All fees **MUST** be paid in advance. Child Care Subsidy is available through the Missouri Department of Child Services if your family qualifies. **All fees are non-refundable.**

*Regularly scheduled field trips and activities are included in the tuition fee.

*School lunch is available during June; otherwise students are required to bring a sack lunch and two snacks every day.

* Additional information will be sent home in April.

Summer Safari FAQ's

When is Summer Safari available?

Summer Safari is available from 6:30a - 6:30p when summer school is not in session. During summer school in June we offer care from 6:30a - 7:45a and 3p - 6:30p. We do not offer full day Summer Safari during Republic R-III Schools summer school program.

How are students split into groups?

Students are divided into four groups based on the grade they are exiting. Group 1 consists of Pre-K and Kindergarten; Group 2 consists of First and Second graders; Group 3 consists of Third and Fourth graders; and Group 4 consists of Fifth and Sixth graders.

How is the program staffed?

Our program consists of 20 part-time staff (not including high school students and volunteers) and 1 full-time director. Our on-site ratio is 1:16 with a field trip ratio of 1:10. A staff list for each group will be provided to you at the start of the program.

In what kinds of activities will my student be participating?

Students will be participating in a minimum of four field trips a week starting in July. Weekly field trips include: swimming and rock climbing at Chesterfield Family Center and roller skating at Skateland. Other field trips include Jump Mania, Branson Attractions, State Parks & Museums, Incredible Pizza and many others.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in many on-site activities which include interest clubs such as Speed Stacks, Cooking, Scrapbooking, Photography, and Computers. Other activities include sports, community service projects, arts & crafts, science, music and movement.

How do I enroll my student?

To enroll your student please detach and return the **BOTTOM PORTION ONLY** along with the \$15 enrollment fee per student. Return completed form and enrollment fee to the Early Childhood Center at 720 N. Main or to your students school office in an envelope marked Tiger STRIPES. A complete enrollment packet will be sent home with your student in April.
