Summer 2019 Programming Options

The Republic R-III School District is excited to offer summer programming for students entering kindergarten through 6th grade for the 2019-2020 school year. Please see the FAQ's section for answers to potential questions.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: FRIDAY, MAY 3, 2019

HOURS OF OPERATION: 6:30 A.M. UNTIL 6:30 P.M.

***CLOSED: MAY 27th AND JULY 4th**

There is a \$20.00 registration fee per student due at the time of registration to reserve your spot.

***All fees are non-refundable.**

Summer Safari (Entering Kindergarten – 6th Grade): Full-Day Programming (May 21st – August 14th):

- Option 1: Full-time (4-5 days/week) - \$100.00/week
- Option 2: Part-time (2-3 days/week) - \$77.50/week

***Note: Summer Safari is a full summer program, different start dates must be approved by the STRIPES 360 office.**

- Option 3: Prepay for the entire summer by May 13th and receive a discounted rate.
 - Full-Time: \$1150.00
 - Part-Time: \$905.00

***There will be a 10% multi-child discount for families with more than one student attending the Summer Safari program and choosing option 1 or 2.**

Tiger STRIPES (Entering Kindergarten – 6th Grade): Before and After School during Summer School (May 28th – June 21st):

- Option 1: Before School (K-5th Grade ONLY) - \$19.25/week
- Option 2: After School - \$36.75/week
- Option 3: Before and After School (K-5th Grade ONLY) - \$54.25/week

***There will be a 10% multi-child discount for families with more than one student attending the Tiger STRIPES program.**

Note: We do accept state child care assistance and adoption/foster care subsidies.

Other payment methods: cash, check, money order or credit/debit card.

STRIPES 360 Summer Programming FAQ's

1. When and where is Summer Safari available?
 - Summer Safari is available Monday – Friday from 6:30 AM to 6:30 PM beginning May 21, 2019 and ending August 14, 2019 at McCulloch Elementary.
2. When and where is Tiger STRIPES available?
 - Tiger STRIPES will be available for **Lyon Elementary** summer school students at Lyon Elementary from 6:30 a.m. until summer school begins and after school until 6:30 p.m.
 - Tiger STRIPES will be available for **Schofield Elementary** summer school students at McCulloch Elementary from 6:30 a.m. to 7:45 a.m. and after school until 6:30 p.m. ***Note: Students will be walked to and from Schofield in the mornings and afternoons.**
 - **Sixth grade (middle school) students will be bused to McCulloch Elementary for after school care (May 29th – June 22nd). Before school care is not available for sixth grade students.**
3. Can my student attend Summer School and Summer Safari?
 - YES...students may register for Summer Safari attend Summer School/Tiger STRIPES and then return to Summer Safari on June 24th.
4. Do I have to pay when my student is not able to attend?
 - YES...There are no credits/refunds due to absences relating to illness, vacations, church/sports camps, or other situations that are not in our control.
5. Are the students all together or divided into groups?
 - Students are divided into groups based on the grade they are entering in the fall. Groups will be determined after enrollment numbers are reviewed.
6. How is the program staffed?
 - Our on-site staff to child ratio is 1:16, and when on a field trip that ratio is 1:10. There will be a site leader and/or assistant site leader on duty at all times as well.
7. What types of activities will be available to my student during Summer Safari?
 - Students will be participating in 2-3 off-site field trips a week. Field trips include Incredible Pizza, Sky Zone, Springfield Cardinals, The Amazing Pet Show and Castle Rock Water Park plus many more!
 - Students will also have the opportunity to participate in a variety of on-site organized activities including: sports, games, cooking, and creative arts. This summer each week will have an exciting theme such as Space Voyage, Animal Planet, Shark Week, Sports Extravaganza and Food Frenzy. On-site activities we be based on the theme of the week.
8. What types of activities will be available to my student during Tiger STRIPES?
 - Students will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of on-site organized activities including: sports, games, and creative arts. This summer each week will have an exciting theme and on-site activities will be based on the theme of the week.
