An abstract is a document that describes what a piece of work is about.

This will be where you describe what your piece of art is and why you created what you have created. It is not acceptable to say that you created it because you were assigned the project. Be sure to describe the types of symmetry that are included in your piece of art and where they exist. Be sure to make the abstract look aesthetically pleasing by choosing an appropriate size, style, and color of font; center justify all of the text. If you have questions or want to check your abstract ahead of time, then bring in a rough draft and I will be glad to do so. The abstract should be neatly typed and creatively designed to include extras over and beyond what can simply be typed up in a word document. Consider how to "dress" up the abstract and "frame" it for additional points.
